14. What are the seven books of the General Letters division in the New Testament? James, I Peter, II Peter, I John, II John, III John, Jude.
15. What is the one book in the Prophecy division of the New Testament? Revelation
16. What are the three Dispensations Periods of the Bible? Patriarchal, Jewish, Christian
17. Who lived in the belly of a great fish for three days and three nights? Jonah
18. What weapon did David use to battle Goliath? A slingshot
19. Did Pharaoh's daughter find the baby Moses floating in a basket on the river Nile or the river Jordan? The river Nile
20. Which disciple attempted to go to Jesus by walking on the water? Peter
21. Whose voice did Moses clearly hear coming from a burning bush? God's voice
22. Giving the "first fruits" to God meant offering the first part of one's crop. True or False? True (The fruits of the first crop were dedicated to God)
23. Is the Old Testament longer or shorter than the New Testament? Longer (OT 39 books, NT 27 books)

24. Who said, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life"? Jesus (at the Last Supper)
25. Was the rebuilding of the Temple in Jerusalem completed during the reign of King Cyrus or King Darius? King Darius (who allowed the Temple to be rebuilt according to an earlier decree by King Cyrus)
26. Are the city of Ninevah and its evil ways described in the book of Micah, Nahum or Obadiah? Nahum (who foresees future doom for the city of Nineveh)
27. When told he must give up his riches to gain eternal life, did the rich man sell his possessions or walk away? He walked away
28. How many days did it take God to create the world? Six days (God rested on the seventh day)
29. What is each book of the Bible divided into for easy reference? Chapters and verses
30. Who took Jacob into his home after he stole Esau's blessing? Laban (Jacob's uncle, his mother's brother)
31. Does the Hebrew name Immanuel mean "God is good" or "God is with us"? God is with us (Mt. 1:23)
32. Did Abraham purchase a cave for his family's tomb in Hebron, Shiloh or Jerusalem? Hebron (Abraham bought the cave and the field around it from the Hittites)
33. Who calmed a great storm on the Sea of Galilee with the words: "Quiet! Be still"? Jesus
34. What terrible place of torture and death were Shadrack, Meshack and Abednego hurled into? A fiery furnace
35. Who lost three thousand camels when God tested the limits of his faith? Job (who regained his wealth after proving his faith despite his terrible misfortunes)
36. Fill in the last word of Jesus' promise to his first two disciples: "I will make you fishers of \_\_\_\_\_"? men (Jesus said these words to Simon and Andrew, who were fishing when he called them.)
37. Adam and Eve's first two sons were named Cain and Abel. What was their third son named? Seth (the father of Enos)
38. What was used to create the golden calf in the wilderness? The gold from earrings belonging to the Israelites' wives, daughters and sons.
39. Which city was NOT on the banks of the Sea of Galilee: Tiberius, Capernaum or Cana? Cana (a city near Nazareth and the site of Jesus' first two miracles)
40. In the Old Testament, God sometimes performed His miracles through the prophets. True or False? True (Elijah and Elisha were two of the prophets chosen by God to perform His miracles)
41. When the Good Samaritan found a man lying in the road, did he pass him by or stop to help? He stopped to help (because he had compassion on him)
42. According to 1 Peter, who prowls around like a roaring lion? The devil (looking for someone to devour)
43. Which is the shortest book in the New Testament? The second epistle of John (with fourteen verses)
44. Was Timothy listed as a disciple or apostle? Neither (He was a companion and assistant to the Apostle Paul.)
45. Which is sharper than a double-edged sword: the word of God or a friend's promise? The word of God (Hebrews 4:12)
46. Was Jesus crucified outside the city of Jerusalem or Bethlehem? Jerusalem

47. What happened to Lot's wife when she looked back at the burning city of Sodom? She turned into a pillar of salt.
48. Who learn the lesson that you can "run but not hide"? Jonah
49. How many trees in the Garden of Eden were forbidden to Adam and Eve? One (the tree of knowledge of good and evil)
50. Which disciple denied Jesus three times before the rooster crowed at dawn? Peter
51. Is a biblical song called a psalm or a proverb? A psalm (There are 150 psalms in the book of Psalms)
52. Name the river where John the Baptist performed most of his baptisms? The river Jordan
53. When the Pharisees wanted to see a miraculous sign, Jesus said the sign of Jonah would be given. True or False? True (Just as Jonah spent three days in the fish, Jesus would spend three days in the heart of the earth.)
54. What small, four-legged green animals were one of the plagues upon Egypt? Frogs (which went into the houses and even into Pharaoh's palace)
55. After Jesus' trial, who asked the question: "What crime has he committed?" Pontius Pilate (who handed Jesus over to the soldiers even though he found no basis for the charges against him)
56. Which appeared on the Apostles' heads on the Day of Pentecost: tongues of fire or doves of peace? Tongues of fire
57. After his three temptations in the wilderness, was Jesus attended by angels, ravens or lambs? Angels (Jesus was exhausted and hungry after fasting and praying for forty days)
58. How many baskets full of bread were left over after Jesus fed 4,000 men, plus women and children? Seven baskets
59. How many baskets of bread were left over after Jesus fed 5,000 people? Twelve baskets of bread
60. Was the Old Testament written primarily in Hebrew, Greek or Latin? Hebrew (called "the language of Canaan" in the Old Testament)
61. Who is the first person in the Bible to be called a Hebrew: Abraham, Isaac or Jacob? Abraham (Genesis 14)
62. Did Jesus say God had numbered his disciples' fingers or the hairs on their head? The hairs on their head (Jesus was reminding the disciples that their lives were in God's hands)
63. Did Jacob raise his twelve sons in Moab, Canaan or Ammon? Canaan (inhabited by the Canaanites until the conquest of the Israelites)
64. What did God do to the wheels of the Egyptian chariots that were chasing Moses and the Israelites? God made them fall off (so the Egyptians had difficulty driving)
65. What did Jonah do while he was inside the great fish that swallowed him? He prayed.

86. Quote Acts 2:38 – (Repent) - Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
87. Quote Matthew 10:32,33 – (Confess) - Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.
88. Quote Galatians 3:27 – (Baptism) - For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. (Also Acts 2:38)
89. Quote Revelations 2:10 – (Live Faithfully) - Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast *some* of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
