The Old Testament Talks About Taking Your Family to Heaven

Deuteronomy 6:1-25

- 1. God's Word must be passed on to each successive generation.
- 2. Careful obedience motivated by dedicated love for God must be taught to each generation.
- 3. Every opportunity must be used to teach God's Word.
- 4. This is so that God is not forgotten during comfortable and prosperous economic times.
- 5. Successive generations must be taught to obey God so that they will not turn to false religious beliefs.
- 6. Be ready to answer the questions of your children.

Malachi 2:13-17

- 1. Marriage is an institution God loves and which must be cherished by people.
- 2. A purpose in marriage is to raise godly offspring.

Ephesians 6:1-4

- 1. Children must obey their parents.
- 2. Children must honor their parents.
- 3. Fathers must bring their children up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Titus 2:1-5

- 1. Women love their husbands.
- 2. Women love their children.
- 3. Women be discreet, chaste, good, homemakers who are obedient to their husbands.

Colossians 3:18-21.

- 1. Wives submit to your own husbands as is fitting in the Lord.
- 2. Husbands love your wives and do not be bitter toward them.
- 3. Children obey your parents in all things.
- 4. Fathers do not provoke (make them bitter) your children lest they become discouraged (without heart or spirit, to become despondent).

Do you want your spouse to go hell or heaven? Do you want your children to go hell or heaven? If you want your family in heaven it is going to require significant commitment and sacrifice. Let us devote ourselves to helping our spouses and our children to be in heaven.
