God's Remedy for Hydrophobia (Part 6)

So, why should we "fear" water? The answer is that Noah, Israel, Naaman and the blind man all believed God. They trusted Him enough to do what He said. They didn't trust in water, but they trusted in God: even when He used water to deliver them! It was God that used water to save Noah. God used the Red Sea and the cloud to "*baptize unto Moses*" all of Israel, but it was God that saved them. There was nothing neither magical nor curative about the waters of the Jordan, but only after Naaman dipped in it seven times did God cure him. And the pool of Siloam had no medicinal qualities to cure blindness, but the Lord Jesus cured the blind man when he washed as the Lord directed. None of these trusted in "water salvation," but water was used by the Lord in each case.

I believe that Jesus said, "*He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved*" (Mk. 16:16). I believe that the Lord commands, "*Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for remission of sins*" (Acts 2:38). I believe that when a sinner puts his trust in the Lord, and is baptized in water as the Lord said, the Lord will save him (Acts 8:35-39; 22:16). But I don't believe in water salvation. I believe the Lord saves. Just as Noah, Israel, Naaman and the blind man believed God enough to do what He commanded, so must we.
