Would You Confess Christ Today?

So many times in giving the invitation preachers refer to Matthew 10:32-33 with regard to the confessing of Christ before men as a part of the plan of salvation. The verses read: ***“Therefore, whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven.”***

Jesus spoke these words to His disciples by way of encouragement and warning. He was speaking to them about persecutions they might encounter. When they were questioned about their faith and when life or death depended on the answer they were encouraged to confess Jesus on those and all other occasions. If they confessed Him, He would likewise confess them before God. If they denied Him, He would also deny them.

J.W. McGarvey wrote that the denial and immediate repentance of Peter is not under consideration here. He also wrote that the confession of Jesus made at the beginning of one's Christian life is not under consideration

either. However, that confession and the one considered in Matthew chapter ten, have something in common. That point is that one may be overcome by temptation to not confess Christ.

You may have already made the “good confession,” (1 Timothy 6:11-13). But perhaps you haven’t. That confession would come after one has decided to believe that Jesus is indeed the Son of God and that His blood can truly cleanse you of the guilt of all your past sins. Following that faith one would naturally repent of those sins, understanding that he would not want to continue in those things that helped to crucify Christ. Upon those things happening, one has made up his mind that because of God’s grace faith in His Son is made necessary and that faith would prompt one to be obedient and confess Christ before men. Upon that confession one would then be baptized for the remission of his sins. Have you done those things that lead one to confess Christ and would you be baptized into Christ for the remission of your sins? Why not consider it today?
