PSYCHICS (FORTUNE TELLING)

I remember the first time I saw an advertisement for the Psychic Hotline. What is interesting is that they have a disclaimer that says that this is just for entertainment purposes. Interestingly enough, many still "swear" by them.

Fate is defined as follows: "In Greek mythology, three goddesses who determined human life and destiny. Known as Moirae in Greek and Parcae in Latin, the Fates apportioned to each person at birth a share of good and evil, although one might increase the evil by one's own folly...The decisions of the Fates could not be altered, even by the gods." [Funk & Wagnalls New Encyclopedia, 1983]

There are other means used to determine one's fate that are just as suspect.

- a. Devices (crystal balls, Quija boards, tea leaves, Tarot cards, dreams, omens, animal entrails, etc.). (Ezek. 21:21-23) (Acts 19:19)
- b. People involved (fortune tellers, mind readers, psychics, palm readers, diviners, etc.).

But there are problems encountered when one believes in fate.

- a. Gets one's mind set on that course and will lead them in the wrong way.
- b. Causes one to not take responsibility for their actions.
- c. One will not try to change their course (no use, hopeless, etc.).
- d. People will follow predictors of fate. (Acts 8:9-11)

The truth is...

1. Those who predict fate are false prophets. (Deut.18:20-22) (1 Jn. 4:1)
2. We are free moral agents and we determine our destiny. (Mk. 16:16; Re.22:17)
3. We in contrast to fate will have to personally give account for our actions. (2 Cor. 5:10)
4. Seeking counsel from such sources is forbidden. (Lev. 20:6)
5. No one can read your mind or destiny. (1 Cor. 2:11)
