Thermometer
Tape Measure
Yardstick
Speedometer
Tire Pressure Gauge
God's values

They are all standards of measurement. Maybe God's values threw you off in determining the answer to the question. How are God's values a form of measurement?

Well, like a thermometer or a yardstick or a pressure gauge, God himself is a standard of measurement. If you want to measure distance you might use a yardstick. If you want to measure the speed of an automobile you might select a speedometer. But if you want to consider whether an action or an attitude is right or wrong you would most certainly want to measure it by God's values.

For example, some people think that theft of small "inconsequential" items from work or "covering" for an employee by punching his time card for him if he is late for work is not a big deal. However, God has a different idea about stealing and lying. God's revealed word says, "Ye shall not steal, neither deal falsely, neither lie one to another." (Lev 19:11) One might be harboring a resentment or hold a grudge against one his brethren God's values teach us to love one another, "A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another." (John 13:34-35)

Whenever we have question about our conduct and actions we should always allow God's values to be our standard of measurement.
