God's Remedy for Hydrophobia (Part 5)

The Blind man had been blind from birth (Jno. 9:1). When Jesus had "spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay," the Lord then told him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam." We then read: "He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing" (v. 6-7). This man had never seen. Neither family nor friends, not even medical experts, had been able to help. But now he could see. Why?

The pattern is well set by now, isn't it? He believed the Lord. He did what the Lord said. He was healed when he washed in "the water" of the pool of Siloam. You would never convince him that water couldn't help him!

If we are to be saved from sin, we must put our trust in the Lord: "God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." (Jno. 3:16). Jesus Christ died for our sins: "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God; being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: whom God set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood... But God commendeth his love towards us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (Rom. 3:23-25; 5:8).
