BLASPHEMY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (Pt. 4 of 4)

The Bible tells us that all scripture is given by inspiration of God (2 Tm. 3:16). It tells us that "Holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost" (2 Pt. 1:21). It was the Spirit, whom Jesus sent, that would guide them into all truth (Jn. 16:13). It was this comforter, Jesus said, who would teach all things and bring to remembrance all things Jesus taught (Jn. 14:26). What they spoke and wrote is characterized by Paul as the "sword of the spirit" i.e., "the word of God" (Ep. 6:17). Paul also says that a man acquires faith by hearing the word (Ro. 10:17). It was the Holy Spirit that was to bring the message of the gospel of Christ (Ac. 2:4; 4:8).

Man blasphemes against the Holy Spirit when he rejects the message of the Holy Spirit. To explain Matthew twelve; Jesus was saying, that you can say what you want to about me, but if you reject the Holy Spirit, there will not be any means of forgiveness, as you have rejected the only means of forgiveness--the Spirit's message!

The Bible presents other occurrences where it speaks of one who has rejected the Spirit's message. Hebrews 6:4-6, speaks of one who exists in an impenitent state, and describes his condition as "Impossible to renew him again unto repentance, seeing they crucify the Son of God afresh and put him to an open shame." You can't make someone repent if they don't want to! Hebrews ten says when one sins willfully after they have received the acknowledgment of the truth, there remains no more sacrifice for sins. How then can one be saved if they have rejected the message? In conclusion, any unrepented and/or unconfessed sin is "unpardonable," as there is no longer any means of pardon available.

The Pharisees would never have spoken against the Father or the Spirit, and this attack was solely directed toward Jesus, in order to discredit him. This was a personal attack on Jesus and his works, not the Holy Spirit. Jesus never accuses the Pharisees of blasphemy against the Holy Spirit, but warned them if they did they could never be forgiven.
