THE PRODIGAL SON

In recent days there has been considerable talk on the importance of reclaiming those Christians who have wandered away. In our efforts to do this the story of the prodigal son is most touching. In this story recorded in Luke, Chapter 15, our Lord makes it quite clear that He is very much pleased when one who has wandered away comes "home". Should we show any less concern than our Lord for those who have slipped back into the world? There are a good number of these precious souls in our own community. Others are showing signs of becoming indifferent and are drifting on a downward course. Have we shown the proper concern for their spiritual wellbeing? We all need to be stimulated to action in this area of great concern.

I have reason to believe that many in the congregation have a deep concern for the wayward Christians. There is no doubt that restoring erring brethren back to the fold would stimulate church growth as much as anything we could possibly do. It will strengthen the church as a whole, and those outside the church will see the love we have for one another.

The apostle Paul says that restoration is possible according to his writing in Galatians 6:1-2. The only reason for our delay in this matter is a lack of initiative and concern. Since this is true, there is no time to waste. We have waited too long already-our delay has been costly, because some have already passed from this life never having repented of their unfaithfulness. Let's not allow any more blood to be upon our hands as a result of our indifference to the wayward child of God. C.S.
