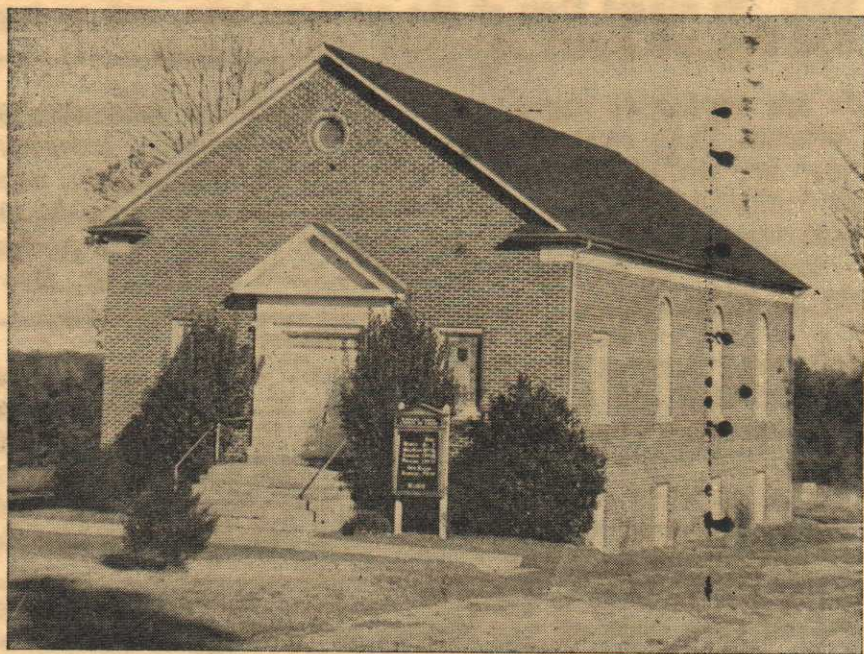

AM I MY BROTHERS KEEPER? GEN. 4:9

After Cain had killed his brother Abel. God came to him and this question was asked him. Where is thy brother, Abel? Cain in return asks, Am I my brother's keeper? We note the first of Cain's reply was a falsehood. I know not. Then with the audacity of an ingrate asks God if he is the keeper of his brother. He knew he had murdered him. He was not willing to abide by God's word. And having failed to do so, when his offering was rejected he was wroth. Hatred for the brother who had done as God commanded. Read Gen. 4 chapter through 12. This question should be a challenging one to us today. Do we first say I don't know? Cain knew where Abel was. You and I can know where those are who absent themselves from service. Read Ezekiel. 3:17 through 21. Also Gal. 6:1. Then read James 5:19,20. Yes, we are our brothers keeper. He could possible be sick, so it is our duty to visit him. Matt. 25:43. If he is discouraged we should seek him, and strengthen him. Bal. 6:2. Have mercy on him, and ye shall obtain mercy. Matt. 5:7. If death has invaded his home, weep with him. Rom. 12:15. Some unfortunate circumstance might have overtaken him, if so help him every way you can. Remember the parable of the lost sheep? Luke 15:3,7. The Master says, finding him, and bringing him back, causes rejoicing in heaven. Jesus says, So likewise ye, when ye shall have done all these things which are commanded you, say, we are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do. Begin with Luke 17:1 through 10, get the entire lesson. Yes, my brother and sister, we owe much to each other. Let us be more concerned. Let it not be said at the judgment, You met me day by day, and knew I was astray, yet you never mentioned him to me. Peter says, 1st Peter 3:8. Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, be pitiful, be courteous. Paul says

Romans.12:10. Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honor preferring one another. Read also kindred passages. Heb. 13:1. 1st. Thess. 4:9. 1st Peter 1:22. 1st Peter 2:17. Also chapter 4.8. 1st John 3:11. Through 24. Yes, love will make us care for our brother or sister. Love worketh no ill to his neighbor love therefore is the fulfilling of the law. Romans 13:10.
