TRUST GOD

We must always trust God. We must trust His word, His way, His will. We must trust in His promises and in the power of prayer. There are numerous examples given to us in the Bible that show the power of trusting in God.

Moses showed great trust in God when the Children of Israel came out of Egypt and were trapped between the Egyptian army and the Red Sea. As the people were panicking and complaining Moses said, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. The LORD will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace" (Exodus 14:13-14). Moses trusted in God and God delivered the people that day.

Jonathan, the son of Saul and friend of David, showed tremendous trust in God when he and his armor bearer chose to take on an entire Philistine garrison by themselves. Jonathan said to the young man who bore his armor, "Come, let us go over to the garrison of the uncircumcised; it may be that the LORD will work for us. For nothing restrains the LORD from saving by many or by few" (1 Samuel 14:6). Jonathan and his armor bearer climbed the cliff to the Philistine garrison and promptly killed twenty in battle, causing the other Philistine soldiers to panic and run. From the distant point where Saul and his army were camped it looked like the Philistine army was just melting away. The Lord saved Israel that day through the courage of Jonathan and the trust he had in God.

David showed tremendous trust in God when the huge Philistine warriors challenged the Jewish army. As the Jewish army cowered in fear while refusing to take up Goliath's challenge,

David said to Saul, “Let no man’s heart fail because of him; your servant will go and fight with this Philistine” (1 Samuel 17:32). Saul did not believe David was up to the challenge and said, “You are not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him; for you are a youth, and he a man of war from his youth” (1 Samuel 17:33). To which David replied, “Your servant has killed both lion and bear; and this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, seeing he has defied the armies of the living God. The LORD, who delivered me from the paw of the lion and the paw of the bear, He will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine” (1 Samuel 17:36-37). David then went and killed the Philistine giant.

Hezekiah showed steady trust in God when his city was surrounded by the Assyrian army. The Assyrian army had conquered the ten northern tribes of Israel and had destroyed many of the fortified cities of Judah before laying siege to Jerusalem. King Hezekiah of Jerusalem entered the temple to pray and encouraged others to do the same. Hezekiah’s prayer is recorded for us in 2 Kings 19:15-19. As a part of that prayer, Hezekiah said, “Now therefore, O LORD our God, I pray, save us from his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that you are the LORD God, you alone” (2 Kings 19:19). Isaiah the prophet came to speak to Hezekiah about the prayer and said, “Thus says the LORD God of Israel: because you have prayed to Me against Sennacharib king of Assyria, I have heard” (2 Kings 19:20). On a certain night the angel of the LORD went into the Assyrian camp and killed 185,000 soldiers. In the morning the remaining Assyrians had no choice but to return home. Hezekiah trusted in God and God saved him.

David wrote, “The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust” (Psalm 18:2). The wise man wrote, “Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding” (Proverbs 3:5). Isaiah said, “Trust in the Lord forever, for in YHWH, the Lord, is everlasting strength” (Isaiah 26:4). When Paul told the church at Corinth of the terrible ways in which he had suffered in Asia, Paul said, “We had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God who raises the dead, who delivered us from so great a death, and does deliver us; in whom we trust that He will still deliver us” (2 Corinthians 1:9-10).
