## ***HOW TO ENJOY STUDYING THE BIBLE (Pt 3)***

The Bible contains two main divisions. The Old Testament was written for a specific purpose: to prepare the way for the coming of Christ and His new covenant.

1. Galatians 3:24 - "Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ.
2. Romans 3:20 - "Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight.
3. The Law of Moses prepared a sinful world for the coming of the Messiah.

The Old Testament was abolished:

1. Colossians 2:14 "...took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;"
2. Hebrews 9:15-17 - (:15) "And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. (:16) For where a testament is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. (:17) For a testament is of force after men are dead: otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth."

Knowing this division is important. One might think he is still bound to the practices of circumcision, keeping of feast days, and the abstaining from different kinds of meats. One might think he would not have a direct relationship with the heavenly Father but would still need to go through a separate priesthood.

An understanding of the proper divisions between Old and New Testaments will allow us to understand that the New Testament is a better one.

At the baptism of Jesus (Matthew 3:13-17) and at the Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1-5), we read that the Father is pleased with the Son, and that we should hear Christ’s teaching, not Muhammad. Hebrews 1:1-2 also confirms for us that God has spoken through His Son.” — Paul Kirkpatrick
