Deacon Duty Description Open/Close Building

- Prepare quarterly assignment sheet for families to unlock/lock doors and turn lights on/off in main building and annex (as needed).
- Each assignment will consist of Sunday AM/PM and the following Wednesday PM.
- Monitor situation to insure doors in main building and annex are unlocked/locked, lights are turned on/off, fans are turned off, Thermostats checked and windows are closed.
- Provide new assignment sheet to secretary, post copy on bulletin board in foyer of main building, and remind participants (as needed).

Deacon Duty Description Lord's Day Assignments

- Prepare quarterly assignment sheets for following responsibilities:
 1. Announcements (monthly basis).
 2. Sunday AM or PM opening prayers (weekly basis).
 3. Serving Lord's table (monthly basis).
- Provide new assignment sheets to secretary and post copy on bulletin board in foyer of main building.
- Monitor situation to insure that faithful men are utilized (confer with elders as needed).
