God's Remedy for Hydrophobia (Part 2)

When people became so wicked that *"every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually"* (Gen. 6:5), God purposed to *"destroy them"* (Gen. 6:6). But God saw that Noah was a just man, and gave him directions to build *"an ark of gopher wood"* (Gen. 6:14). When the flood came, Noah was safe in the ark while a sinful world was destroyed. We read in Heb. 11:7, *"By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, and moved with fear prepared an ark to the saving of his house."*

Some will argue, "Noah was not saved by water. The ark saved him from the water." This reasoning ignores the plain statement of God's word: *"When once the long-suffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water."* (1 Pet. 3:20). God stated it, I believe it: Noah's family was *"saved by water."* Certainly the ark saved them from the water (death by drowning), but the water also saved them from something. God said so. What was it that God destroyed? It was a sinful world (Gen. 6), and God used water to destroy that sinful world. Noah's family was *"saved by water"* and left the ark to a clean, pure world.

Elders Corner:

HOW TO GET ALONG WITH PEOPLE

1. Keep skid chains on your tongue - always say less than you think. Cultivate a low persuasive voice. How you say it often counts more than what you say.
2. Make promises sparingly and keep them faithfully no matter what it costs you.
3. Never let an opportunity pass to say a kind and encouraging thing to or about somebody. Praise work well done regardless who did it. If criticism is needed, criticize helpfully.
4. Be interested in others, their pursuits, welfare, homes, families. Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. Let everyone you meet feel that you regard him as one of importance.
5. Be cheerful, keep the corners of your mouth turned up. Hide your pains, worries, and disappointments under a smile. Laugh at good stories and learn to tell them.
6. Preserve an open mind on all debatable questions. Discuss but do not argue.
7. Let your virtues, if you have any, speak for themselves and refuse to talk of other's vices. Discourage gossip. Make a rule to say nothing of another unless it is something good.
8. Be careful about another's feelings. Wit and humor at another's expense is rarely worth the effort.
9. Pay no attention to ill-natured remarks about you. Simply live that nobody will believe them. Disordered nerves and bad digestion are common causes of backbiting.
10. Don't be too anxious about your dues (what is due you). Do your work, be patient, keep a sweet disposition, forget self and you will be rewarded.
