Leadership Authority

Some feel that Titus 1:5 gives preachers equal or superior status with elders, because of the mandate "to set in order the things that are lacking and appoint elders in every city." expressed to the young preacher Titus. No where in the scriptures do we see preachers having equal or superior authority to elders, unless the preacher is a qualified and appointed elder.

The scriptures imply that no elder is superior to his fellow elders. If elders meet the qualifications, they are of equal status before the Lord, for they meet the standards set by God.

The fact that a preacher may know or understand the qualifications for elders does not give him equal status with elders. He simply knows or may understand what God requires of all elders. The eldership has authority over the entire congregation including the preacher: Heb. 13:17. The inference of the plurality of the eldership prohibits any one man having authority over a congregation.

Since an eldership has a mandate or command from God to feed and protect the flock, does this exclude the preacher or for that matter a fellow elder? A qualified eldership holds the qualifications that God has given. In fact each elder in the eldership should consider all of his fellow elders his elders for a more cohesive leadership.

No where in the scripture is a preacher required to hold the qualifications of an elder, except to qualify as elder. Normally the eldership hires the preacher and therefore has authority over him and the preacher should meet the standards required by the eldership. If the preacher fails to meet those standards, does the eldership have the right to dismiss him? The next question would be: do they have the authority to hire him? It seems logical that the answer to both questions is yes.

If one holds that preachers are equal or superior in authority with elders, one would be contributing to the denominational preacher pastoral oversight system which is foreign to the New Testament. It seems that some desire this concept to have a more secure position. Some preachers feel they have superior knowledge to elders due to their advanced training or education. This position fails to recognize that the qualifications for elders create the ideal situation for leadership. If elders truly qualify, they fulfill God's design to lead a congregation and its preacher.

ELDERS CORNER:

The elders want to offer a sincere thank you to all those who contributed money so Steve Martin could go to Zambia and visit the work we support there. As usual, when members at Warners are made aware of a need or opportunity to help others, you respond liberally.

It is apparent that you want to help spread the gospel in other lands and help those less fortunate.

The trip was very successful in that Steve witnessed the graduation of 20 preachers who will go home and work with their congregations or start new congregations. He was able to spend some time teaching the graduates about leadership in the church and provided them with printed material to take home to study and teach to others. This material will reinforce what they have been taught during their two years in school.

The funds you provided also helped several needy people, in addition to providing needed equipment and supplies for the school, including Bibles for distribution. (More on this later).

The drip irrigation kits we sent in June have been well received and we are told they are a big help in making good use of what little water they have in the dry season. When the rivers go dry in the summer months, some find water by digging down in the river bed until they find some water underground. It has started raining there now and it looks to be a good growing season. People are busy planting crops including maize which they depend on the most.

Steve will prepare a presentation on what was accomplished as soon as he can put it together. Thanks again for your help and encouragement and especially your prayers for his safe return.
