BLIND AND PREJUDICED

Guillermo Gonzalez earned his PhD in Astronomy from the University of Washington. He has authored 68 peer-reviewed scientific papers. These papers have been published in some of the world's most respected science journals. Dr. Gonzalez co-authored a college textbook entitled *Observational Astronomy* which was published by Cambridge Press.

Dr. Gonzalez is currently a professor at Iowa State University. Recently he applied for tenure but was denied. He had fulfilled all of the qualifications for tenure, and had actually gone far beyond those qualifications. Despite his qualifications, he was denied. Ninety-one percent of the professors who applied for tenure the same year at Iowa State were successful. Dr. Guillermo Gonzalez appealed the ruling. In June, the president of the university denied his appeal. Why wasn't this professor given tenure?

As it turns out he was denied tenure because he has written a book entitled *The Privileged Planet*. In this book, he argues "There is evidence for intelligent design in the universe." This book presents scientific fact as evidence of intelligent design. Two of the professors who rejected his bid for tenure specifically said that Gonzalez's belief in intelligent design played a role in his rejection.

While man science departments are working hard to keep their professors from suggesting there is evidence of intelligent design within the universe, more and more scientists are coming to that very conclusion. Recently the Discovery Institute compiled a list of over 700 scientists who signed a statement that includes the following sentence: "We are skeptical of claims for the ability of random mutation and natural selection to account for the complexity of life."

CONFIDENCE IN PRAYER

We pray that God will help us to be a congregation that pleases Him. We can pray for those that are suffering. We can pray about the work of the church. We can ask for all of these great spiritual blessings and more and have the full confidence that God will answer our prayers.

God will bless the congregation whose members pray fervently, in accordance with His will, and who pray frequently. "Pray without ceasing (2 Thessalonians 5:17).
