"A Good Description"

A little fellow in the 6th grade hygiene class turned in this sparkling description of the human body: "Your head is kind of round and hard, and brains are in it and your hair on it. Your neck is what keeps your head out of your collar. It's hard to keep clean. Your shoulders are sort of shelves where you hook your suspenders ... Your spine is a long bone in your back that keeps you from folding up. Your feet are what you run on, your toes are what always gets stubbed. And that's all there is of you, except what's inside, and I never saw that!

Of course, this young boy was describing the body that he saw, and the description is not bad. But there is much more to man than his body. The Apostle stated in I Thess. 5:23: ". . .and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved entire, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."

In Eccl. 12:7, we read: "that when death comes to our body, the spirit of man returns to God who gave it." And in Matt. 10:28: "And be not afraid of them that kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: But rather fear him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell."

There are some people who teach that the body and the soul are the same, yet this passage proves that one can kill the body, but not the soul. It is true that the word "soul" is used in the Bible sometimes to indicate people - as ;in the case of the eight souls saved in the ark (I Peter 3:19-20).

From the verse in Matt. 10:28, we note the soul is still alive after man kills the "body". Hence, "soul" here refers to man's immortal spirit. The body apart from the "spirit" is dead. This is the body that dies, but not the "soul", "spirit" of man.
