Everyone one of us will come to that point in our lives when we will only have a few days left to live. Jesus Christ knew when He only had a few days to live (Matthew 26:1). He knew exactly how and when He would die. In addition, Jesus knew that His death would be very painful.

Would you be filled with dread, despair, and anguish if you knew you were about to die in a way best described as excruciating? Now, what if you had the power to stop that death from coming? Would you do it? Would you choose to avoid that painful death, or would you go through with it?

Jesus Christ was filled with a sense of dread as His death approached (Matthew 26:37). He even asked His Father if there was another way (Matthew 26:39). There was no other way. In order for man to be saved from sin, only the blood of the sinless Son of God would satisfy the justice of the Most high, Pure, and Holy God. So, Jesus faced His agonizing death with courage.
