North Carolina School of Biblical Studies - Update

Isn't it wonderful to be back in worship again and to be getting a bulletin? I want to take this opportunity to thank everyone at the congregation who have made us feel so welcome, even under restricted visiting and worshipping opportunities.

As you know, due to Cofid restrictions, we have not been able to begin regular on campus classes for the school. It is in our plans to do that next year. We believe we will be able to meet Covid requirements and still have class. The curriculum is set and we will begin recruiting in earnest for the 2021-22 school year.

In the meantime, **Journey Through the Bible** begins January 7 for the ladies (Instructor: Teresa Glenn). **Developing Leadership Practices That Work** begins January 7 for men or ladies (Instructor: Mike Glenn).

Teresa and I have had the privilege of conducting three online Zoom classes. *Ladies*, if you have not had the opportunity to participate in Teresa's class, I strongly urge you to be part of the class that will begin, Thursday, January 7, 2021. The class is titled **Journey Through the Bible**. It will help you understand how events, types and prophecies of the Old Testament tie together and join with the New Testament as part of the entire picture of God's plan to save mankind. The class beginning in January will be the second part of the class already taught. **BUT**, the first class is not prerequisite for the second. Please come on in and be a part of the learning.

While registration has not officially opened for any classes yet, Teresa has already had requests from 50 ladies to sign them for the next class. If you cannot participate in the Zoom

At this time in our world's history, the covid virus has made it essential to be creative in finding ways to grow the kingdom of God.

This class will both explore and put into practice, with online collaboration, a number of effective Biblical concepts for strengthening and developing a leadership that works in building momentum for the kingdom.

These online classes we are holding are not just something to do during covid. They are planned leadership and Christian growth series.
