AT WHAT ARE WE AIMING?

We the Church of Christ make it our aim to further a cause, a movement, comprising churches and individuals, for a complete return to Christianity as it was at the beginning. HENCE WE STAND:

(1) For the Bible as the all sufficient standard of faith and practice. Recognizing that what God required from his ancient people Israel, is in the Old Testament. And what he requires of us now is contained in the New Testament.

(2) For the union of all believers on the New Testament basis. Our Lord prayed that "they all might be one.....that the world may believe." (Jno.17:21) This prayer makes the union of his people essential to the salvation of the world. It can only be answered when there is a return to the faith, ordinances, and order of the church of the Apostolic age.

(3) For the rejection of all HUMAN creeds, confession of faith, doctrines, and commandments of man, and the acceptance of the Divinely revealed creed, "Thou art the Christ the son of the Living God," believing that a real heart-grip of that, with all it implies, will lead to a complete surrender of life and will to him.

(4) For the abandonment of all sectarian names and ecclesiastical titles, such as, "Reverend" "Most Reverend" "Father" etc. And that churches and believers should be called by the names found in the New Testament.
