Throw away all of these old "stock" excuses and come to Bible Study Sunday morning. Let's have our 83 B.S. members present and all of the others possible.

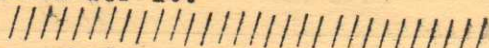
Bible Study Changed to 10:00
