DO YOU KNOW MY JESUS?

He is the only gift to the world that God did not create, yet He was despised rejected (John 1:1-3; 3:16; Isa. 53:3). He was the most important person ever born, yet He chose a stable as His birthplace (Luke 2:7). He was the most important child the world ever knew, yet His parents once went an entire day without missing Him. When found, He said that He had been about his Father's business (Luke 2:43-49). He never sinned, yet through His ministry He became known as the, "friend of sinners and tax collectors" (Luke 7:34). He knew how to pray (Mark 1:35). The tempo and tenor of His entire life was shaped by the way He prayed (Luke 11:1-4; Matt. 26:36-46). He was busy with matters of eternal weight and import, yet He considered it important to hug and to bless little children (Mark 10:13-16). He was the greatest teacher who ever lived, yet people were often greatly offended by His values, challenges and demands (Luke 11:38-54). On several occasions the people He taught turned against Him or left Him altogether (John 6:66; Mark 14:50; 15:13-14). He touched lepers, paid special attention to widows, visited with a Samaritan woman, ate with tax collectors, called common fishermen to follow Him, and never enrolled in the "best" schools of His day, yet His ministry permanently changed the world for the better (Mark 1:41; Luke 21:2; John 4:9-10; Luke 19:1-10; John 7:15-19). He was God in the flesh, yet one of His favorite ways to answer religious questions was by asking, "Have you not read what is written in the Scriptures?" (Matt. 22:31; Mark 12:10; Luke 6:3). He created the world and everything in it, yet He described Himself as One who came to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many (Col. 1:16; Mark 10:45). While on trial for His life, It was recognized by many that He had done no wrong, yet before

His accusers He opened not his mouth (Matt. 27:14, 23; Isa. 53:7; 1 Pet. 2:21-23). He was subject to the greatest injustice in history, yet during his excruciating execution, His words reflected concern for others and confidence in God (Luke 23:34; John 19:25-27; Luke 23:46). He rose from the dead and could have vindicated Himself immediately, yet instead He showed compassion to the world by commanding His disciples to preach the Gospel to every creature (Mark 16:15-16). He will return from heaven one day and will judge the world. He will make no mistakes in His judgments (Acts 17:30-31). Are you prepared to meet Him on that day?
