The Benevolent Conqueror

The precise and accurate fulfillment of Biblical prophecy is one of the great evidences of the Divine origin and inspiration of the Holy Scriptures. The Old Testament in particular is filled with prophesies of the rise and fall of nations. When Daniel interpreted the Dream of King Nebuchadnezzar around 600 BC, Daniel showed God's great prophesy of the fall of Babylon and the rise of Persia (Daniel 2). Daniel's own visions later predicted the same (Daniel 7). King Cyrus the Great holds a place of prominence and importance in the Biblical text, and is one of the most historically well known of the ancient kings of Persia.

National Geographic says, "Cyrus went down in history as one of the most benevolent conquerors of all time, allowing his subjects to live and worship as they pleased." The ancient Greek writer, Xenophon referred to Cyrus as "a humane, benevolent, and loving soul." Recently Benjamin Netanyahu said, "I want to tell you that the Jewish people have a long memory, so we remember the proclamations of the great King Cyrus the Great, the Persian King. Twenty-five hundred years ago he proclaimed that the Jewish exiles could come back and rebuild our temple in Jerusalem."

History recognizes what the Bible records concerning the benevolent king and conqueror, King Cyrus the Great. God, through the prophet Isaiah spoke of King Cyrus about one hundred years before Cyrus was born (Isaiah 44:28-45:1). In perfectly accurate prophesy, Isaiah spoke of the fact that Cyrus would allow the Jews to return from exile and rebuild the temple in Jerusalem.

Some years after the time of Isaiah, the inspired prophet Jeremiah spoke of the time when the Jews would be released from the Babylonian captivity by the decree of King Cyrus (Jeremiah 29:1-14). Jeremiah prophesied of the fact that the Jews would be in exile for a

period of seventy years from the time of the first captives being carried into Babylon. The first captives were carried into Babylon around 607 BC, meaning the decree of Cyrus occurred around 537 BC.

When Daniel was old he knew the seventy year period of exile was near the end. He had been reading the works of Jeremiah and calculated it would not be much longer before the Jews would go home (Daniel 9:1-19). Daniel prayed to God for the forgiveness of his people and the fulfillment of the prophesy made through Jeremiah.

2 Chronicles 36:15-23 provides an excellent summary and overview of this period of Jewish history. The inspired author records a statement concerning God's efforts through faithful prophets to bring the people of Judah and Jerusalem back to Him. The people refused to repent so God sent the Chaldeans (Babylonians) to punish them. The temple and palaces were burned and the walls were broken down by the Babylonians in the final attack on Jerusalem. Chronicles then records, "And those who escaped from the sword he carried away to Babylon, where they became servants to him and his sons until the rule of the kingdom of Persia, to fulfill the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had enjoyed her Sabbaths. As long as she lay desolate she kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years. Now in the first year of Cyrus King of Persia, that the word of the LORD by the mouth of the prophet Jeremiah might be fulfilled, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, so that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and also put it in writing, saying, 'Thus says Cyrus king of Persia: All the kingdom of the earth the LORD God of heaven has given me to build Him a house at Jerusalem which is in Judah'" (2 Chronicles 36:20-23).

The exact and precise fulfillment of the Biblical prophesies concerning Cyrus the King of Persia give evidence of the Divine origin of the Bible. The historical references to Cyrus the King of Persia lend support to the acknowledgment of the accuracy of the Biblical text. Read the Old Testament with the confidence that it is the most accurate record of ancient rulers, kingdoms, and events. Enjoy it, even as you do the New Testament, as the Divinely inspired Word of God.
