DON'T PUT YOUR CHILDREN ON THE WRONG TRAIN"

As the train was beginning to roll out of the station the conductor began to take up tickets. Looking at the first passenger's ticket, the conductor said, "Friend, I think you're on the wrong train." This story teaches the importance of godly leadership in the home and in society. Our sin can hurt others and what we say and do has more influence than we might realize. One of the qualifications of an elder in the Lord's church is to rule his own household well, 1Timothy 3:4. Raising our children in the fear and admonition of the Lord is a vital part of our responsibility to God, family and country. Don't put your children on the wrong train – don't cause them to jump track.
