Learning To Work In A Covid Environment

It has been and will continue to be a challenge to accomplish certain things during this Covid-19 pandemic. We had originally planned to begin classes for the North Carolina School of Biblical Studies. Covid hit and stopped the normal methods of recruiting and congregating, so we did not get started. Worship assemblies stopped for a time. Many planned events for the church came to a halt while we tried to figure out methodology that glorified God in our efforts to worship, work, keep people safe, obey the law and still reach out in evangelism. To say the least, it became and still is a huge learning curve in regard to all that we can effectively do. So, how shall we proceed.

I am thankful to the elders that they are continuously monitoring the situation and striving to make wise decisions that are safe and feel safe to everyone. At least two things are planned this year that allow us do our work: we are moving forward to open the school for classes in August and the elders have scheduled Rob Whitaker to hold an evangelism seminar this fall. These two events give us an opportunity to do something right now, not only to prepare for them, but to challenge us to use our ingenuity in serving Christ during the pandemic. Please let me explain and give you a challenge.

Your brothers and sisters are going to be a big part of helping our students become the kind of preachers they need to be. One of the areas that is very important is evangelism. We will have the NCSBS students to begin focusing on that during their second quarter of the school year. Evangelism also happens to be the focus of Rob Whitaker's seminar and it is certainly the primary work for the Lord's church. So, how do we prepare right now??? We need good soil, good hearts that will be receptive. I would like to ask you to do your best to 'cultivate the ground' and prepare the soil (Matt. 5:16, 13:23). That is, we can start right now striving to open hearts among our family, friends, neighbors and co-workers. To do that, WILL YOU ACCEPT A CHALLENGE TO DO GOOD?
