Temptation and Us

James 1:12–15 (NKJV) — 12 Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. 13 Let no one say when he is tempted, “I am tempted by God”; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He tempt anyone. 14 But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. 15 Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death.

The word blessed is very beautiful because it means, not only happy but one who is blessed or has received blessings from God. The Theological Dictionary of the New Testament states:

“It denotes the transcendent happiness of a life beyond care, labour and death, ...used of men to denote the state of godlike blessedness hereafter in the isles of the blessed...extols human happiness; possession and happiness are inseparably connected here.”

In other words, it is the state of being happy and blessed inwardly BECAUSE there is a connection of receiving something hereafter. We can be happy because there is something that is beyond just trying to get through a situation or circumstances where we find ourselves. In this situation of context, we are talking about temptation. We can be blessed in that we are set on receiving a crown of life when this life is over BECAUSE we chose to stand against temptation rather than give in to it. This has been promised to us and we can rest assured that the promise will be fulfilled if we only choose to follow the instructions that lead to that result.

James then focuses on the nature of God. He states that God cannot be tempted by evil nor does He tempt anyone. The reason behind this is that God is the definition of GOOD and cannot lead anyone to do that which is against His will. God’s nature is light and in Him is NO

DARKNESS AT ALL (1 Jn. 1:5). He is LONGSUFFERING and not willing that ANY SHOULD PERISH (2 Pet. 3:9). He is everlasting in GRACIOUSNESS (Ps. 86:15). God CAN NOT lead someone to sin or to turn from His will because it is absolutely against His nature.

So where does temptation come from? It comes within OUR evil desires. We all have our own devices and lusts that are particular to us. We each have something that draws us that doesn't draw others because of our past lives and our attractions. Notice how James describes this:

14 But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. 15 Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death.

This language is that of a fishing analogy. Just as a fish is lured to a particular bait that he desires, he then soon comes to it and takes the bite. He then has to suffer the consequences of his desire - death. The same thing goes for us. Since we all are drawn away by our particular desires, when we finally pursue them and partake in them, we die (Rom. 6:23). The way that we prevent this from happening is to constantly be on guard and fill our hearts with the Word of God (Ps. 119:11).

This passage teaches us that overcoming and enduring temptation IS POSSIBLE! We just have to decide to overcome it knowing that hereafter we have something GREATER than the fulfillment of our desires that will only satisfy until the next time. What will we choose?
