Grace and Works

There are at least three significant passages in the New Testament where Paul emphasizes our salvation by the grace of God. In each case Paul places a powerful statement regarding the importance of works at the end of the discussion of grace. It as if the Holy Spirit anticipated that any passage of Scripture that emphasized the magnificence of the grace of God might be taken out of context and used to teach works have nothing to do with our salvation.

Romans chapter five contains a powerful passage emphasizing the reality that we are saved by the grace of God. But, it is immediately followed up by a moderating statement given to prove that salvation by the grace of God does not exclude works of obedience to God (Romans 6). Romans 6:17 tells us the people who became Christians in the church at Rome did so when they obeyed from the heart the form of doctrine. God's grace saves us but only when we obey Him. To suggest salvation by grace is available for those who choose to live in rebellion to God is to teach a lie. We are saved by grace, but only when we choose to obey God.

Ephesians 2:8-9 includes an important statement regarding the reality of salvation by grace through faith. We are even told in this context that works whereby we could boast of earning, or deserving our salvation are excluded. However, this statement is followed up with the comment that we have been "created in Christ Jesus for **good works**" (Ephesians 2:10). Additionally, grace must be accompanied by faith, and while Biblical faith excludes all works of boasting, it does not exclude works of obedience to God (James 2:14-26)

Paul wrote a wonderful and encouraging passage regarding the grace of God in his letter to Titus (Titus 2:11-3:8). Paul says "the grace of God that bring salvation has appeared to all men (Titus 2:11). Then the text tells us this was done so that God may "purify for Himself His own special people, **zealous for good works**" (Titus 2:14). In the same context Paul later says, "that having been justified by His grace we should become heirs of eternal life, and then concludes this with, "This is a faithful saying, and these things I want you to affirm constantly that those who have believed in God should be careful to **maintain good works**" (Titus 3:7-8).

Works of the law of Moses are excluded from salvation. Works of merit and boasting are excluded from salvation. Works of obedience unto God are required for salvation by the grace of God (Revelation 20:12-13).
