IS IT TIME TO UPDATE?

Times change. The new quickly become old, the modern is ancient, today's technological breakthrough quickly becomes yesterday's news, the popular is lost in "the latest," and the up-to-date is soon out of date.

Truth never changes. It reads the same today as it did yesterday and as it will tomorrow. It is "once for all delivered to the saints" (Jude 3) Those who would change it are "accursed" (Galatians 1:6-9) and find that it will meet them in judgment unchanged (Rev. 20:12).
