*Not everyone is going to go out to preach. But Paul wrote, **“How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace.” (Ro.10:15).** When all things are considered, your love for the gospel and the love for the gospel of these men combine to spread the borders of God’s kingdom. When you consider your giving today remember: what’s love got to do with it.*

After that we will dig the foundation. Plans for fund raising will be met, that we can accomplish our plans. I will also help the untrained preachers with the skills of sermon outlines, so that they also have the access to deliver well prepared lessons to the audience that they may not chase rabbits. We promise that we will make sure that this congregation follow the New Testament pattern of worship till the Lord's coming.
