WHAT ABOUT BRING HERE THIS COMING SUNDAY EVENING?

SEVEN OBJECTIONS TO DENOMINATIONAL BAPTISM

1. It has the wrong authority.

Jesus never commanded men to be baptized into any denomination. Gal. 3:27.

2. It has the wrong subject.

It is the penitent believer who is to be baptized, not the man who thinks he is already saved.

3. It has the wrong confession.

Men must confess Christ, not "feelings", if they would qualify for scriptural baptism. Acts 8:37.

4. It has the wrong purpose.

It baptizes to get into a denomination instead of the church of the Lord; it baptizes "because of" remission of sins instead of "for the remission of sins". Acts 2:38-47.

5. It has the wrong allegiance.

Sectarian "baptism" binds men to wear a denominational name; to obey and endorse a denominational creed, organization and program.

6. It has the wrong order.

Its order is: Repentance, faith, salvation, baptism. The Bible order is Faith, repentance, confession, baptism, salvation. Acts 2:36,38,41; 8:37; 18:8.

7. It has the wrong emphasis.

It attracts people to denominational names, creeds, and programs instead of attracting them to the Christ, his will and his kingdom.
