TOP NINE REASONS TO LOVE PEOPLE

1. People are important.

In last week's article, we gave the "top ten reasons why people are important." Those are as follows:

- 1) God loves you
- 2) God wants you to be in heaven
- 3) God created you
- 4) God died for you
- 5) God wants you to have hope
- 6) God wants you to be in His family
- 7) God gave you free-will
- 8) God wants you to love Him

- 10) God gave you a priceless message

2. People have eternal souls.

"For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul" (Mark 8:36-37)? "Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them" (Acts 2:41).

3. People have inherent value.

"For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:6-8).

4. People are loved by God

“In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so love us, we also ought to love one another” (1 John 4:9-11).

5. People are created by God.

“So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He create them” (Genesis 1:27).

6. People should be treated as we want to be treated.

“Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law And the Prophets” (Matthew 7:12).

7. People are not animals.

“So Adam gave names to all cattle, to the birds of the air, and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a helper comparable to him” (Genesis 2:20).

8. People are suffering and need help.

“But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was. And when he saw him, he had compassion. So he went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him” (Luke 10:33-34). “But whoever has this world’s goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him” (1 John 3:17)?

“But the fruit of the Spirit is **love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness**” (Galatians 5:22). “Fulfill my **joy** by being like-minded, having the same **love, being** of one accord, of one mind” (Philippians 2:2). “For we have great **joy** and consolation in your **love**, because the hearts of the saints have been refreshed by you, brother” (Philemon 1:7).
