Help to Resist Those "Fiery Darts"

You may never have heard of Joseph Damien. He was a nineteenth century missionary who ministered to people with leprosy on the island of Molokai, Hawaii. The lepers grew to love this man and revered the sacrificial life he lived in their midst.

One day, before the daily morning devotional, he spilled hot water on his bare foot. It took him a moment to realize that he hadn't felt **any** sensation. Knowing what that could mean, he poured more hot water on the same spot. Again, he had no sensation whatsoever. He went on to services and no one caught it at first – but instead of starting with his usual words, My fellow believers," he said, "My fellow lepers," Damien could fully relate to the lepers because he became a leper. He knew personally the struggles that they faced. He could actually feel their pain.

The Bible says this about Jesus: "... in all things He had to be made like His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, in order to make propitiation for the sin of the people. For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are being tempted."

When you feel tempted to do that which is wrong and you want the strength to resist; remember, you have a Savior who knows exactly how that feels and He will help you withstand those "fiery darts."

ELDERS CORNER:

The elders at Warners Chapel believe it is important to periodically visit and encourage the works we support with your contributions. On November 4th Steve Martin will leave for Zambia to visit the work of the "Zambia School of Biblical Studies".

While there for 16 days he plans to: (1) Speak to the school students about the need to develop leadership in each congregation of the Lord's church. (2) Attend the graduation ceremony of the present class of 20 students on November 15th. (3) Visit some of the areas in the bush where irrigation drip kits are being used. Warners sent 200 drip kits to Zambia in June of this year to be used by preachers to raise food for their families during the dry season. (4) To visit some of the congregations within traveling distance of the school to encourage them.

While there we will have many benevolence and evangelism opportunities. There is a need to reproduce some good teaching material for use by the brethren there. The students and instructors do evangelism campaigns on the weekend when money is available for gasoline (\$6.00 per gallon). There is no money in the school operating budget for this. Several congregations have been started from these continuing efforts. If you would like to give money to help with benevolence and evangelism in this area of Zambia, please make your check to Warners Chapel and put it an envelope and write Zambia on the envelope.
