I will try the best I can to work with my congregation, then I will analyze the situation whether to go ahead or change. The current situation at hand is choirs, one cup doctrine, youth and women organizations. This is the battle I am going to face and I don't want any support from anybody because their money is hindering God's work to progress due to restriction they put on what to teach and not.
