#### **SELFISH-AMBITION**

I do believe that one of Satan's most effective and most divisive weapons against individual Christians, individual congregations, and the Lord's church around the world is the sin of selfish-ambition.

Selfish-ambition causes elders to seek authority above the other elders and to have their way no matter the cost. For this reason, we are told elders are not to be self-willed (Titus 1:7). Self-ambition causes preachers to become jealous of other preachers and works. Preachers with selfish-ambition view their jobs as a profession in which one must climb the ladder, rather than a way of life, to which one is wholly devoted. This is why Paul reminds us that preachers are to be considered servants of Christ and stewards of the Gospel (1 Corinthians 4:1-2). Selfish-ambition can cause men and women in the local congregation and in the church as a whole to bring about caustic, bitter, and divisive attitudes that destroy the unity of the church. That is why Paul tells all Christians, "Let nothing be done through selfish ambition ..." (Philippians 2:3). Nothing! Let nothing be done through selfish-ambition! Nothing!

The words "selfish ambition" in the NKJV translate the Greek word, "kenodoxia." This is a compound word made up of "keno" (vain or empty) and "doxa." W.E. Vine's Expository Dictionary of New Testament Words defines "doxa" as "the honor resulting from a good opinion." The New Thayer's Greek English Lexicon defines "doxa" as "praise or honor coming to someone." The idea of self-ambition (kenodoxia) is the idea of someone seeking praise and honor which is empty. It is empty because it is of no value. Those who seek to be glorified and honored by men in the church are those who are guilty of "kenodoxia" (vain glory - KUV). Too many men and women in the Lord's church are seeking the empty glory and praise of men. They want to be viewed as big-shots in the local church, or important people among many brethren. They want to be looked up to and praised by other Christians and recognized to be something great. Such vain glory seekers are guilty of selfish ambition and are arrogant and foolish. These selfishly ambitious people inevitably hurt the church.

Thayer says "kenodoxia" means, "groundless self-esteem and empty pride." Zodhiates defines it as a "desire for praise." Such people want to be told they are so much more important than others. These individuals want to be elevated above fellow Christians. Those guilty of this sin, love the praise and glory of men. They are shallow. They are empty. They think they are big, but they are small. They think they are everything when they are nothing. They puff themselves up with power and influence then go about seeking to wield that influence, perhaps not realizing their actions are destructive to the unity of the Lord's church, and endangering to their own souls.

Jesus spoke of those guilty of this sin when He said, "Therefore, when you do a charitable deed, do not sound a trumpet before you as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory from men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward" (Matthew 6:2). And it is because of the very dangers this arrogant self-glorifying desire for the praise of men poses, that Paul says, "Nor did we seek glory from men, either from you or from others" (1 Thessalonians 2:6). Paul had seen the Christ! Paul had established numerous congregations through the preaching of the Gospel! Paul was an apostle! But look! Paul says he did not seek glory from men! Why would some elder, preacher, deacon, teacher, or other member of the Lord's church seek glory from men when Paul would not?

It is utter foolishness, and completely destructive to seek glory from anyone other than God. The glory we seek from Him is a glory we do not deserve, and yet it is a glory He will give us if we humbly go about doing His work. That is the glory of the new body, the resurrected body, the body that will be in heaven with God forever (Romans 8:18-25; 1 Corinthians 15:42-44; Philippians 3:8-21; 1 John 3:1-3)! That is the only glory we seek! The glory of men is pitiful, pathetic, and useless. It is indeed a vain, empty, and selfish glory. The undeserved reward God will give us if we humbly serve Him is immeasurably glorious!

And so, my beloved brethren, "let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bonservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross" (Philippians 2:3-8).
