YOU CAN OVERCOME

How many times have you been set back, knocked down, and defeated? How hard is it to keep getting up? Who does not face suffering, obstacles, complications, and frustrations in life? What Christian does not face a continual battle against Satan? Can you make it? Of your own strength and power apart from God? No. If your dedication is accompanied by God's strength and power? Yes. Yes you can make it. Yes you can have the victory. You can overcome?

You can overcome even though you may have to travel through the most dire of circumstances in your life. Paul was burdened beyond measure on at least one occasion (2 Corinthians 1:8). Paul was a faithful Christian but God allowed him to be burdened beyond measure. Have you been burdened beyond measure? If so, you are not alone. Was there anything good that came from this heavy burden that Paul suffered under? Paul answers, "Yes, we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves but in God who raises the dead" (2 Corinthians 1:9). Isn't this what burdens teach us? We cannot trust in ourselves. Some matters are beyond our ability to control and correct. Sometimes we don't have the ability in our own strength, intelligence, wisdom, and endurance to overcome. So, we are diligent, but we learn we must trust in God rather than in ourselves. We are very limited, but God's power is unlimited. God can give you the strength to overcome.

Do you put all your hopes in this world? If so, you cannot overcome. The world will defeat you (1 John 2:15-17). Are you instead pressing "toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:14)? If so, then you can overcome. You can overcome because of the strength you receive through Christ (Philippians 4:13). Do you know our citizenship is in heaven (Philippians 3:20)? Then you eagerly wait for Jesus to return and to transform your lowly body to be conformed to His glorious body (Philippians 3:21). You have a glorious body coming to you at the resurrection. It is glorious in that it will enable you to live in heaven with God forever. If this is your confidence, then you can overcome.

We have enemies. Satan is an enemy (1 Peter 5:8-10). He wants to devour your soul and destroy your life. He wants to take the hope out of your heart and the joy of salvation out of your mind. He wants to shred and destroy your life. You must resist him. You must resist him steadfastly. You must resist him steadfastly in the faith. You cannot resist him apart from the faith, or outside the faith. You cannot resist hi if you are not sober, vigilant, and steadfast. You must be diligent knowing that the brotherhood throughout the world suffers. You are not alone. You must be diligent know that God of all grace (beautiful expression), who called us to His eternal glory (beautiful hope) by Christ Jesus will help you. He will reward you. After you have suffered for a while He will perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you! The God of all grace will help you to overcome.

Death is another enemy (1 Corinthians 15:26), It is an enemy because it hurts us when our loved ones leave this earth. Each soul, and each spirit is powerful, unique, and incredibly valuable. When our souls interconnect with the souls of others through love we establish bonds that cannot be fully explained and which are not fully appreciated until the spirit and soul of another is gone. Then there is loss. There is vacuum. There is void. There is emptiness. There is loneliness. And so it hurts. And so it is our enemy. But it will be destroyed. When Jesus Christ returns to this earth He will destroy death (1 Corinthians 15:24-28). He has conquered death through the resurrection, and He will destroy death for all on the great resurrection day. So, for the Christian, even death cannot defeat us. And so we say with Paul, "thanks to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord" (1 Corinthians 15:57-58). Victory will be ours. Death will not have the final victory (1 Corinthians 15:55)! You can overcome. With God's help, you will overcome!

Let us pour out our hearts in fervent prayer to God (James 5:16). Let us trust in His power to strengthen us so that we might glorify Him in this life, and receive the glorified body in the life to come. Let us encourage, uplift, and strengthen our beloved brothers and sisters in Christ! Let us fight together. Let us help one another. And, let us tell the world of the hope, peace, joy, and victory that is to be had in Christ Jesus our Lord! We can overcome!
