FOR THREE TRANSGRESSIONS, YEA FOR FOUR...

Amos was a herdsman from Tekoa. He was not a schooled preacher, prophet or orator. "I was no prophet, neither was I a prophet's son; but I was an herdman, and a gatherer of sycomore fruit." (7:14)

As a result of this lack of "credentials," his audience did not welcome him or accept him as a spokesman for God. Reading the book, one is impressed with the tone of the harsh and stern proclamations against Israel. Not just Israel alone, but Amos brings a stinging rebuke to the southern kingdom of Judah in chapter six: "Ye that put far away the evil day, and cause the seat of violence to come near; That lie upon beds of ivory, and stretch themselves upon their couches, and eat the lambs out of the flock, and the calves out of the midst of the stall; That chant to the sound of the viol, and invent to themselves instruments of musick, like David; (6:3-5)

Damascus, Philistia, Tyre, Edom, Ammon, and Moab, are also condemned for their disobedience to God. These nations were not particularly favored by God. God's favored nation was the Jewish nation and yet God warns the surrounding nations that His wrath would be upon them as well.

Those in the World today who refuse to bow to the God of Heaven are under the same laws and rules as those who have committed themselves to God and accepted the Lordship of Jesus Christ. God will still condemn those for "three transgressions, yea for four."
