SALVATION (Part 1)

Paul plainly taught that the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men (Tit. 2:11). Thus, if one is saved by grace alone-that is, without having to make any response whatever to the word of God then it follows that because God loves all men, then all men will be saved. But Jesus taught that few would be saved and that many would be lost (Matt. 7:13-14). Jesus further made clear that only those who "do the will of God" "shall enter into the kingdom of heaven" (Matt. 7:21).

The writer of Hebrews declared that even though Jesus was "a Son, yet learned obedience by the things which he suffered; and having been made perfect, he became unto all them that obey Him the author of eternal salvation. . ." (Heb. 5:8-9). Jesus also emphasized that merely hearing the word is not sufficient; one must both hear and obey the word (Matt. 7:24-27).

James said, "Ye see that by works a man is justified, and not only by faith" (Jas. 2:24). James further taught, "For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, even so faith apart from works is dead" (Jas. 2:26). That which is dead is powerless, inoperative, and unable to accomplish anything at all.

Jesus made clear that even faith itself is a work (John 6:28-29). He taught in this passage that faith is a work, not which God does for man, but which is required of man and approved by God. No one can be saved without believing in God (Heb. 11:6). No one can be saved without believing in Jesus Christ as the Son of God (John 8:24; 20:30-31). But faith without obedience cannot save one from his sins (Jas. 2:24-26; II Thess. 1:7-9).

JESUS THE GREAT

The world has called a number of men "great," such as Alexander the Great and Herod the Great. They were great in power, in courage, in military or political skill, but they were not great in any spiritual sense. Jesus is by far the greatest man who ever lived. None less than an angel from heaven announced: "He shall be great," in foretelling His birth (Luke 1:32). Of only one other man is it said in the Bible that he was "great" and that was John the Baptist (Luke 1:15), and he felt unworthy to even unlatch Jesus' sandal (Luke 3:16). Of Jesus it was said, "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:6). He is truly wonderful."

- His birth was the greatest of any man (Isaiah 7:14, Matt. 1:18-23; John 2:10, Heb. 1:6)
- His life was the greatest ever lived (Heb. 4:15; I Peter 2:22; 2 Cor. 5:20; Heb. 5:8; Phil. 2:8)
- His teaching was the greatest of any (Matt. 7:28, 29; John 7:46; Col. 2:3)
- His death was the greatest of any (Jn. 15:13; Gal. 2:20; Eph. 5:25-27) It caused a thief to repent (Luke 23:42) and a hardened pagan solder to marvel (Mark 15:39).

The question remains, "What think ye of Christ?" Who is Jesus to you? What roles does He fulfill in your life? Is He making a real difference? Does His Word rule your heart? Do your actions reflect your love for him? Do you sacrifice for His cause? The Lamb of God now invites; the Lion of Judah will one day return.
