Many times we draw our illustrations and comparisons from our own experiences. One of my favorite television shows of my teenage years was **The Waltons.** Watching the struggles of this depression era family moved me with compassion on several occasions. The specials like the **Walton Family Christmas** portrayed a simpler time. I remember John-Boy's Christmas gift on the first such event, that his father gave him a stack of Big Chief writing tablets and pencils, knowing (and implicitly approving) the son's chosen profession.

Yet my favorite episode was about a Walton family Thanksgiving in 1947 that related a sad fact of a growing family, i.e., "no one's going to be here for Thanksgiving," Elizabeth said. The family had been through a depression and then a war. Mama and Daddy were in Arizona where Olivia was convalescing from Tuberculosis. Most of the older siblings were married or considering marriage. Elizabeth did not seem very thankful for anything.

The times and people do change and things do not stay the same. Our children grow up and form relationships with others. These relationships sometimes cause them to pause to consider the things that are really important. Living a Christian life has given me a new perspective on life and what is truly important. I am thankful everyday for that life and remember the good times this new life has brought me.

I have enjoyed a small blessing throughout my life in that I have never had to go up on the mountain and shoot a turkey for Thanksgiving; Happy Thanksgiving to you all.

THE VALUE OF BIBLE CLASSES

The importance of Bible classes is often overlooked and often questioned. However, organized classes to study the word of God are clearly valuable to the cause of Christ. The aim of Bible classes is to help us get a better understanding of God's word so we might be prepared for heaven and to lead others there also. (II Tm. 2:14, 7, 15; 3:15-17 and Rm. 1:16). Jesus said in Jn. 17:3, "And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou has sent." Bible classes are one way to better KNOW God and Christ!

We are admonished in scripture, "If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God ..." (I Peter 4:11). Again the Bible exhorts, "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear" (I Peter 3:15). Bible classes better prepare us to this end.

The value of Bible study is obvious, Ps. 119:11 "Thy word have I hid in my heart, that I might not sin against thee." Consider also II Tm. 3:15-17, "And that from a child thou has known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through the faith which is in Christ Jesus. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works." Private Bible study is important to this goal, but so is group Bible study (Bible classes). As the psalmist declares, the happy man is one whose "... Delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate DAY AND NIGHT." (Ps. 1:1-2). See you in Bible class!
