Embracing God Seen Through Crossing Jordan (Joshua 3-4)

I. Seeing The Text

- A. God made a promise to give the land – Gen. 12:1, Josh. 1:6
- B. God gives the charge and stipulations for the promise – 3:1-8
- C. Man steps in faith and obedience – 3:14-17

II. The Sign

- A. He Told them what was going to happen – 3:13
- B. The miracle performed – 3:14-17
- C. The purpose – 3:7, 10
- D. God desires that He be given credit – 4:21-24

III. What Does This Mean For Us Today?

- A. God gives US promises – Salvation (Mk. 16:15), Eternal Life (Jn. 3:16), Rest (Matt. 11:28-30), He will never leave us (Heb. 13:5), All necessities will be provided (Matt. 6:25-33), etc.
- B. God always goes before us and will remove the barriers before us! – We must trust and overcome our fears
- C. We must be obedient to what God has stipulated to receive the promises He has given.
- D. When we receive them, we must remember that it was God who brought us here, not ourselves.

IV. Embracing Moment

- A. God wants to bless us.
- B. God will destroy every barrier that is preventing us.
- C. God desires that we step in faith, trust, and obedience,
- D. God wants us to realize that if He brought us over, He will also bring us through.
