## It’s Christ, Not Me

**Galatians 2:20 (NKJV)** — 20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

When we become Christians, we die to ourselves and give our lives to Christ. This means that we put ourselves away to be fully committed to Jesus Christ. But what does this involve? Can I hold onto things that make me or is it a total “handing-over”?

What does the word “crucified” mean? This terminology is very clear and specific in that it means death. When someone is crucified, they are hung there until they are dead. This usage is to get into the minds of the readers the concept that when they become Christians, they have to die to themselves. Another verse that corresponds with this is **Luke 14:27** “And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple.” Another way of putting it is found in **Romans 6:2** “...How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it?” We have to completely die to our selfish desires, attitudes, actions, words, and priorities to that which is approved of Jesus Christ. We, in other words, are to become a living SACRIFICE (Romans 12:1). It is a life that is fully “handed over” to another, and that other is Jesus Christ.

When we fully sacrifice ourselves to Christ, it is no longer us who lives, but Christ who has the reigns of our lives. This means that everything we do is under the governing factor of Christ. This is a commitment that is not to be taken lightly, but a life that is in harmony with what pleases Christ. Think about what Paul said in **Colossians 1:10** “that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;”. It is all about walking in a manner that is all about Jesus.

Now we understand what Paul was meaning when he stated this in Galatians 2:20. He was no longer living for himself, but Christ living in Him. Can this be said of us? Is Christ the center point of our lives? Can it be seen in our choices, treatment of others, and actions?
