## **The Grace of God**

In today’s religious world, there are a lot of different teachings about the grace of God. But we don’t have to know all of the teachings that are out there to know which are right and which are wrong. All we need is to understand what the Bible teaches about it because the Bible is the defining authority on all spiritual matters, teachings, and practices. In this short study, we will define what grace is and how it applies to us.

The grace of God has been defined as the unmerited favor of God. In other words, it is the giving of God not based on anything that man has done, but solely from the heart of God. The way that I define it is that grace is the GOODNESS of God, It is that which flows from the nature of God that truly is a gift to man (Eph. 2:8). It is this goodness that we are saved (Eph.2:8), leads man to repentance (Rom. 2:4), allows us TO BE ABLE to approach God acceptably Eph. 1:6), allows us the ability to be different (Eph. 2:4-7), allows us to be forgiven (Eph. 1:7), allows us to be adopted by God (Eph. 1:5), and gives us the ability to be in Heaven with Him one day (Eph. 1:13-14). It is the only thing that gives us a chance to be saved and the only thing that allows us to be who God wants us to be.

It is so amazing to think that we would not have any chance in life of every standing acceptably before God if it was not for God’s grace. Some might ask why? It is because, in our natural state, we are nothing but sinners (Rom. 3:10; Rom. 3:23). Because of our natural status, this only requires death to be the sentence given to us (Rom. 6:23). If God did not change His attitude toward us, then we would not have any chance of changing our lives. This is SOLELY laid upon the GOODNESS / GRACE of God. What this means is that if it was not for the grace of God, there would be NO CHANCE of ever being right in the sight of God. The beauty of this opportunity given to man is clearly seen in one act - The Cross of Christ (Rom. 5:6-11).

The salvation of man is not SOLELY laid upon God and His grace, but also on our response to that grace. The grace of God teaches us certain things.

**Titus 2:11-14 (NKJV)** —**11** For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, **12** teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, **13** looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, **14** who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.

It calls for us to DENY ungodliness and worldly lusts, LIVE rightly, LOOKING for the end, and be ZEALOUS for good works. God is looking for our response to His grace. So what will we choose? It is so important to understand that God's grace is what WE HAVE TO HAVE to have a chance. God has given it, are you accepting it? Are you willing to do what it calls for you to do? You make that decision!

North Carolina School of Biblical Studies will begin the 2022-2023 year of studies on August 1st. This quarter will continue for ten weeks from August 1st through October 2nd. You might be interested in taking advantage of some of these classes.

Brother Charley Belch will take you on a journey through our history with a study of the book of **Acts, part 2**, every **Monday** morning from **9 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.** You will study about the planting and growth of congregations through the missionary journeys of the apostle, Paul. Even if you did not get to attend last quarter, you will not be behind with this course.
