WHEN BRETHREN DISAGREE (Pt 1)

The Bible teaches us to do our level best to "be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment." (1 Cor. 1:10) In spite of this admonition brethren do not always agree on everything. It seems no matter how hard we try - human nature makes disagreements inevitable (different levels of maturity, ignorance, pride, some more knowledgeable, thirst for power, opinions bound, personality clashes, etc.). Disagreements can be very disruptive and even destructive, but they don't have to be.

Biblical Examples Of Justifiable Disagreement

- 1. Joshua and Caleb disagreeing with the other spies and Israel.
- 2. Jesus disagreeing with the Jewish leaders.
- 3. Paul disagreeing with Barnabas and Peter.

There Are Times When The Right Thing To Do Is Disagree

- 1. If someone is in error and harming themselves. (Tit. 1:13)
- 2. If someone is wrongfully influencing others. (Ac 15:1-2; 1 Tm. 5:19-20)
- 3. If someone is improperly influencing you. (Tit. 3:10-11)

C. The Benefits Of Such Disagreement

- 1. It can help show one the error of their ways and save their soul.
- 2. It can provoke learning and lead one to reconsider their ways and follow a better course. (Prov. 9:8-9)
- 3. It can help preserve and keep the church pure. (Ro. 16:17-18)
- 4. It can be therapeutic as opposed to harboring bitterness or being sorry later for not speaking up. (Heb. 12:16-17)
