"FEEL THE BURN"

A lot of people are really into physical exercise these days. Some are running and exercising. Some are walking, swimming and using cross-training equipment as well. There are some programs that are saying to exercise for just a few minutes while increasing the intensity of the exercises. Still others stick with the older theory, to exercise until . . . You feel the burn.

Some exercises burn more calories than others do. The following activities have been suggested for those who don't find the standard exercises appealing: beating around the bush - 75 calories; jumping to conclusions - 200 calories; throwing your weight around anywhere from 50 to 500 calories (depending on how much you weigh); dragging your heels - 175 calories; making mountains out of molehills - 500 calories; tooting your own horn - 25 calories; adding fuel to the fire - 150 calories.

Now, before you dismiss these activities as harmless endeavors, think about this: engaging in these things all your life, and never exercising yourself to godliness, as the Bible teaches, will ultimately lead to more than just calories being burned. You must obey the gospel to be saved (Mark 16:15-16). The Lord adds the saved to the church (Acts 2:47). The saved person must remain faithful till death (Revelation 2:19; 2 Timothy4:6-8). Obey the gospel and live for Christ now, so that you may live eternally with Him.
