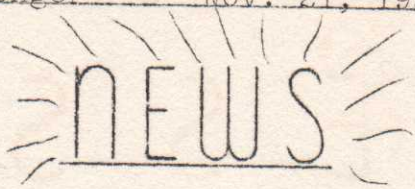

6. There Is Only One Body. "There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling." (Eph.4:4)

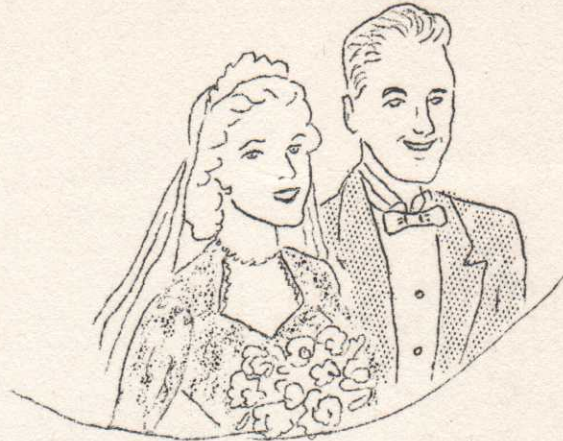
7. The Lord Adds To His Church. "And the Lord added to the Church daily such as should be saved." (Acts 2:47)

 It gives me inward pain."

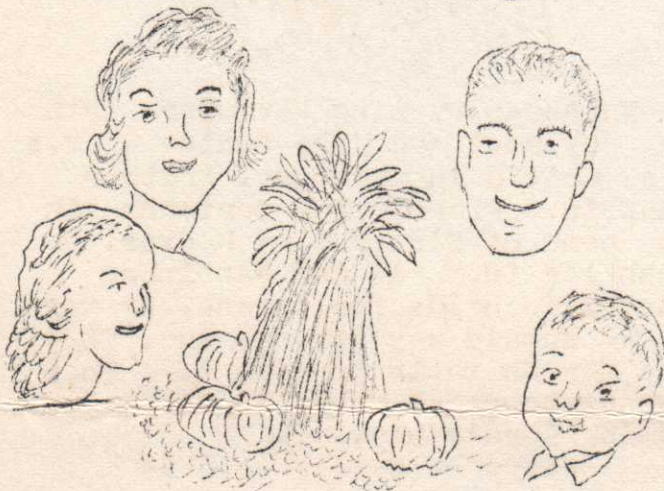
