SALVATION (Part 2)

Jesus tells us that repentance is absolutely essential for us to go to Heaven. He says, "Unless you repent you will all likewise [like those sinners who died when the tower fell, vs. 4] perish" (Luke 13:5). Repentance and remission of sins are found in other passages like Luke 24:47; acts 2:38, etc. God wants all men everywhere to repent (cf. Acts 17:30-31). Just as important as belief is to God in rendering obedience, so also is repentance to those outside the body of Christ.

In Luke 15 we read the story of the wayward son who squandered his inheritance through worldly endeavors. This story shows the care that God has toward any of his children who leave him and wish to return. God's attitude is expressed by the attitude of the Father in the story. It was one of jubilation and happiness. He did not ask him for a written statement of his commitment to him. He did not ask him for "fruit of repentance," but welcomed him back and "began to be merry," (vs. 4).

On the other hand, how sad it is to see the attitude of the Elder Brother that "was angry and would not go in" to the feast. You see, he did not think that his younger brother had done enough for his Father to deserve a feast. The father was not harsh toward the Elder Brother but corrected and encouraged the Elder Brother that he should be happy for his younger brother: "It was right that we should make merry and be glad, for your brother was a dead and is alive again, and was lost and is found" (Luke 15:32).

"I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance." (Luke 15:7)
