Kyle is a native of Southern Indiana and graduated from Freed-Hardeman University with business finance degree in 2000 and an MBA in 2011. He is a Certified Financial Planner and has spent most of his career specializing in providing financial planning services to alumni and friends of Freed-Hardeman University. He also spent two years working as a financial advisor for a large brokerage firm. Article IV

Are You Servant to the Lender?

The Bible is quite clear on the subject of debt: "Pay all your debts". "Let no debt remain outstanding". "Owe no man anything". So why, then, do so many of us utilize debt to pay for what we want and need? While Scripture is quite clear on debt, the Bible does not answer the question of when we should borrow money. We should each have a goal of paying off all of our debt, but in the meantime, the following guidelines should help determine "proper" debt:

- 1. The value of the item is at least equal to or greater than the amount of debt owed.
- 2. The item is an asset with the potential of increasing in value over time or producing income.
- 3. The debt is not so great that the repayment causes extreme pressure on the budget.

We read in Proverbs 22:7, "The rich rules over the poor, and the borrower *is* servant to the lender" (NKJV). If we are in severe debt, we will be ruled by our lenders and not by our God. Today more than ever before, we are inundated with incentives to borrow money and told that getting out of debt is easy. Either way, we lose and the lender wins. Managing our money means having a handle on our debt. The apostle Paul writes in I Corinthians 7:23, "You were bought at a price; do not become slaves of men" (NKJV).
