LABOR DAY

In 1882 the first Labor Day holiday celebration was held to provide a day of appreciation those who were laborers in the U.S. It was also to appease the labor unions. It being a day off from work, maybe it should be called a "No-Labor, Labor Day!"

EVERYONE IS COMMITTED

Paul recently presented a sermon on “commitment”. The purpose of the sermon was to encourage commitment to the Lord and to the work of His church. As the title of this article suggests, everyone is committed; but the question is to what?

We’re all familiar with Matthew 6:24 in which Jesus states: “No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.” Although we understand that you cannot serve two masters, we sometimes fail to realize that a Christian’s lack of commitment to the Lord’s work is in reality a lack of loyalty to Christ himself. A similar idea is expressed in Matthew 12:30 where Jesus said: “He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad.”

Are we with Christ or are we against Him? Are we committed to the work of the Lord’s church or is our commitment choked out by the cares and pleasures of this life? We can say we are with Christ, but if we are not committed to the work of His church, our actions or the lack thereof speak louder than our words. In a little over a week, we will have an excellent opportunity to let our actions speak for us. John Allen has promised to find a way for everyone to be involved in the upcoming Youth Rally. Will we gather with Christ or will we scatter abroad?

In the United States, Patriot Day occurs on September 11th of each year, designated in memory of the 2,993 killed in the September 11, 2001, attacks. Most Americans refer to the day as "Nine-Eleven (9/11)," "September Eleventh," or some variation thereof.

On this day, the President directs that the American flag be flown at half-staff at individual American homes, at the White House, and on all U.S. government buildings and establishments, home and abroad. The President also asks Americans to observe a moment of silence and prayer beginning at 8:46 A.M. (Eastern Daylight Time). Also called Prayer & Remembrance Day for the Victims of 9/11.
