"HOW COULD ANYONE BE UNCERTAIN?"

In 2004 Victor Vroom devised something he called the "expectancy theory." He maintained that people are motivated when four contingencies are met.

First: They must believe that the reward being offered for a particular behavior is worth the effort to get it.

Second: They must be confident of their ability to perform the required task.

Third: They must be convinced that accomplishing the task is possible in the present set of circumstances.

Fourth: They must be certain that the one who made the promise is credible and will keep the promise.

Translation? The Apostle, Paul, wrote, "For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed unto Him until that day. 2 Timothy 1:12.

Paul had an unshakable confidence in Christ's promises of eternal life. He accepted the hardships of preaching the gospel. Some might ask, "How could Paul be so certain?" Paul might have said, "How could anyone know Christ and be uncertain?"
