## Do You Want To Be Made Whole?

In John 5, Jesus asked a question to the lame man at the Pool of Bethesda, "Do you want to be made well?" (Jn. 5:6) In this question, Jesus was asking him if he wanted himself to be made whole or without ailment and to be sound in body. Then, after Jesus came back to the man, He warned him about how there is something worse than not being sound in body and that is not being sound spiritually (Jn. 5:14). Today, we have to ask ourselves the question, "Do we want to be made sound spiritually?" Now what does this mean? This means that the things of sin in our lives will no longer be there. It means that the desire to sin will no longer be there. It means that we will be different than we are right now. Does that sound good or does it not sound too appealing? Do we want to change our ways so that we stand in the right view with God or are we more concerned about how we view ourselves? I believe that some people don't really want to be made well because that would require a change or difference. This can be uncomfortable. This will take effort. But the beauty of it is, that if we change ourselves to be spiritually sound, we will stand in the view of God as a delight, being blessed in ways that only God can bless us with. How do we come to being made well? We must realize that Jesus is the **ONLY SOURCE** for wellness (Jn. 14:6, Matt. 9:12). We must come to light and let our deeds be exposed (Jn. 3:19-21). We must focus ourselves on the eternal pleasures rather than the passing, temporal pleasures of sin (Heb. 1:25). We must give ourselves over to the will and the standard of God (Matt. 7:21, Jms. 1:22-25). When we do this, we will be made whole and sound in our spiritual body. If our spiritual body is sound, then our physical lives will become sound as well.

**So let me ask you again, "Do you want to be made well?"**
