"You Did It unto Me"

There are many works of the church that always need to be done. Some of them are thankless tasks, and others seem to be more rewarding. Let's consider the work of visiting. It's a task that has many facets and rewards as well. There are those who are "shut in" and can't get out and go places. Those are visits that really need to be made. Then there are visits to someone who is incapacitated temporarily that need visiting. There are those who live alone who would really like some company, even if it's just for a few minutes. The hardest type of visit is perhaps the ones made to those who are unfaithful or beginning to fall away. They still need to know that they matter to the Lord and the congregation. Then there are the visits with friends and family that are so enjoyable. These are good visits because good Christian fellowship is promoted when they're made. Some visits are the kind that results in Bible studies with non-Christians. Eventually we could come up with all types of visits. For instance, we were about to leave out the hospital visits, the visits to those who are in prison and those visits to the families of those who are ill.

No doubt, you have already thought about someone you would like to visit or someone who needs a visit. That's part of the purpose of the article. The other part is to remind and motivate "us" that visiting needs to be revived a little bit. There are several that you might name who go visiting but the question is, "Are you one of them?"

You know I almost forgot the visit where two people go visiting together and visit with each other along the way. There is one last aspect to visiting that we need to consider. Jesus said, "I was sick and you visited Me. ... The righteous will answer Him saying, 'Lord ... when did we see you sick, or in prison and come to You?' And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me." (Matthew 25:34-40)


Please Remember In Your Prayers:
